

## **NSF IGERT: Offshore Wind Energy Engineering, Environmental Science, and Policy**

### **Guidelines for applying for an extra year of funding**

Objectives: To maximize number of high quality graduates from the program; so a tension between maximizing number in program and increasing chance of graduation and chance to focus on work.

IGERT Fellows typically get two years of IGERT fellowship funding. We have limited funding allowing IGERT fellows to apply for an extra year of funding. We will likely only fund a small number of these applications.

Minimum requirements to apply:

- A total of 3 funding applications (i.e., 2 grants, one fellowship). These can be submitted by the Fellow or by the Fellow's advisor.
- A year of funding from some other source, such as the department (as a TA, RA, fellowship, other); NEAGEP; any other grant funding, fellowships, etc.
- A successfully defended thesis proposal
- Clear plan for finishing, including a timeline and where any additional funding will come from

Process:

- Apply – due date same as new applications
  - Submit all funding applications
  - Submit proposal
  - Submit record of accomplishments and service to IGERT
  - Submit plan for finishing (both the academic plan and the funding plan)
